Examples of good practice in Romania

Gaining community trust

Open local authorities, free of prejudice and willing to support the Roma community

Mutual knowledge

Continuous involvement (dialogue, courses, projects)

Collection and analysis of community data

Local action plan for the short, medium and long term

Building trust among the Roma community towards the authorities

Well-structured local action plan

Non-discriminating

Real community consultation, not just formal consultation

Different methods of community engagement, specific to each group

Building trust, over time, through "small victories" (concrete actions) Accessing funds from other sources for the disadvantaged community

Needs analysis based on real data

Support in writing projects Facilitating communication

Partnership between local institutions

Local action plan correlated with the local budget

Contribution from the local budget to the implementation of the local action plan

Accessing European funds for the disadvantaged community

Accessing funds to improve infrastructure and housing

Increasing the trust of civil servants in accessing European funds
